RESTORING THEATRICAL MAGIC TO THE MILWAUKEE THEATRE

PROJECT OVERVIEW

Grunau Metals fabricated and installed ornamental and industrial metal work at the Milwaukee Theatre during the historic building's restoration.

SITUATION

Grunau Metals worked extensively on the two-year restoration of the historic Milwaukee Theatre. To enhance the building's half-round rotunda lobby, the metals team fabricated two grand multi-story staircases. The team also installed decorative plasma cut panels on handrails throughout the theatre that display the Milwaukee Theatre logo. In addition, Grunau Metals demonstrated its skills in industrial metalworking by fabricating the theatre catwalks, stage ladders and platforms. They also installed all of the handrails, seating stairs and light support bars located inside of the theatre. The metals team also fabricated and installed more than 18 other public and access stairways throughout the building.

On the exterior of the theatre, Grunau Metals installed hundreds of feet of stylized handrails and guardrails, and two functional but highly ornate, canopied entrances with radius plasma cut panels displaying the theatre's logo. Adding the final touches to the building, Grunau Metals laser cut multi-layered aluminum panels featuring artwork highlighting the city of Milwaukee. The artwork wraps around the top of the exterior walls of the theatre. Grunau Metals was also asked to perform last-minute tasks such as enhancing the front entrance.

Grunau Metals was able to complete the entire job on schedule and in time for the theatre's grand opening, despite initial delays and increased scope of work.

The Milwaukee Theatre can seat up to 4,000 spectators, or the space can be reduced to 2,500 seats for a more personal setting.

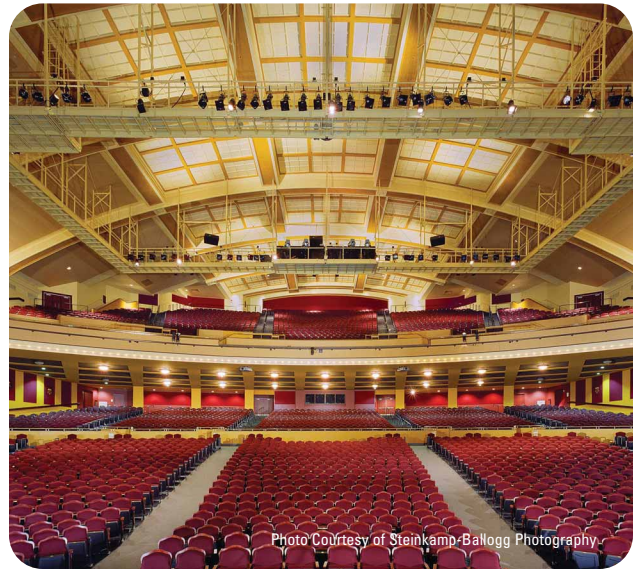
