


New Fabrication Brewing With History


Redeveloping vintage, historic buildings can be fraught with challenges. The Zilber Group, working through KM Development, renovated a building in the Pabst Brewery complex for the University of Wisconsin-Milwaukee School of Public Health. Stairs, railings, support steel, and balcony rails are just some of the architectural elements they called upon Grunau Metals to fabricate and install. Working with carbon and stainless steel. Grunau Metals created these elements to achieve the "high industrial look" that architectural firm Eppstein-Uhen specified. According to Grunau Metals own Dave Douglas, "fabricating new components that blend well with existing antique components was a challenge, but one we were able to meet."
